### Position Overview

An art teacher job description can give you an accurate idea of what the employer expects from you. The principal purpose of teaching art is to boost creative thinking, impart artistic skills to students and make them aware of the social, cultural, political and economic factors that influenced art in different historical periods. For doing this capably, the art teacher requires considerable artistic abilities and knowledge of aesthetics and art history. They also typically require excellent communication, interpersonal and empathetic skills.

### Key Responsibilities

- Plan, develop and implement art history curriculum to meet learning goals.
- Purchase art materials and maintain inventory of art materials.
- Prepare and arrange art materials in the classroom for students to use.
- Deliver lectures to students on art, art technique, art history, and aesthetic.
- Give drawing and painting demonstrations to students to teach them art techniques.
- Instruct students in working in different drawing, painting and colouring techniques.
- Discuss various artistic approaches and traditions and encourage students to express themselves artistically.
- Provide instruction in the use of pencils, pens, charcoals, brushes, watercolours, acrylic colours, oil colours, and other art materials.
- Assign art projects to students, grade the finished art projects, conduct art exams, and maintain records of students' progress.
- Organise art exhibitions to display the artworks of students and help them develop their portfolios.
- Support the School Administration in developing art programmes.
- Ensure all school policies and national regulations are met.
- Ensure a healthy learning center environment – including maintaining appropriate hygiene and cleanliness standards and safety and security of children.
- Maintain accurate records, forms and files.
- Maintain personal professional development plan to ensure continuous quality improvement.
- Attends staff meetings and training sessions.
- Be flexible in the face of changing circumstances or assignments.

### Additional Knowledge, Skills and Experience Required

- Must be born-again Christian.
- Hold a Bachelor's degree in Art or Art Education. GPA must be at least 3.00.
- Certification in Art Education.
- Minimum of two years of teaching experience (this does not include practicum, student teaching, tutoring, or substitute teaching experience) – preferred.

- Ability to work well with others (staff, children, and parents) and to foster a team environment.
